How should Christ-followers engage with others who disagree with us theologically?

"Have nothing to do with foolish, ignorant controversies; you know that they breed quarrels. And the Lord's servant must not be quarrelsome but kind to everyone, able to teach, patiently enduring evil, correcting his opponents with gentleness. God may perhaps grant them repentance leading to a knowledge of the truth, and they may come to their senses and escape from the snare of the devil, after being captured by him to do his will." - 2 Timothy 2:23-26

Basic Beliefs of Anti-theists

Categories or divisions under the "atheist" heading

1. ______- one who believes there is no God.

2. ______ - one who believes there is insufficient evidence to prove or disprove the existence or non-existence of a God.

3. ______ - one who believes real knowledge is unattainable, knowing with absolute certainty is impossible.

All of these, in one form or another, deny the existence of God. Atheists' basic beliefs can be summed up in three ideas: secular humanism, materialism, and scientism.

humanism = a philosophy or life stance that embraces human reason, *secular* ethics, and philosophical naturalism while specifically rejecting religious dogma, supernaturalism, and superstition as the basis of morality and decision making.

_____ = the doctrine that nothing exists except matter and its movements and modifications.

= reality is exhausted by that which can be known by scientific means and so is reducible to purely natural terms.

While there is a place for apologetics, philosophy and friendly discussion and debate, the starting point with any non-Believer is what we have been discussing throughout this study:

In ALL Gospel engagements we don't seek to "win the fight" but to garden the soil of the soul of the person in front of us with the truth and hope that Jesus saves.

Always:

- Pray that God will change hearts
- Be Respectful
- Don't make assumptions
- Ask questions
- Listen
- Seek to understand so you can be understood
- Use the Bible as the bases of Gospel conversations
- Remember the Golden Rule do unto others as you would have them do unto you. *Don't treat someone in ways you don't want to be treated.*
